Subject: Proud to be a Smokefree School

- Effective measures to prohibit smoking in all buildings and grounds, including car parks, owned or utilised by the school.
- Appropriate advice and support to anyone who smokes to remain abstinent whilst on school property or to quit smoking if motivated to do so.
- A comprehensive training plan in very brief advice in smoking for all staff members to ensure staff have the necessary skills and confidence to support a smokefree school.

It is important that all staff members feel confident in both complying and enforcing a smokefree policy. All staff induction sessions will now include information and reference to the Smokefree Policy. Additionally, Public Health at City of Doncaster council have produced a toolkit that will be widely available for all staff members to utilise.

Finally, for any staff that currently smoke and would like support to quit, there is free support available through your local smoking cessation service, Yorkshire Smokefree.
